<p>Work relevant to environmental topics:</p>	<p>Remove CLEAN water BEFORE it enters the public sewer system.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All this water overwhelms the public sewer system. • To provide for efficient and EFFECTIVE wastewater treatment. • To provide capacity for future growth without the need for (very) expensive pump station and treatment plant construction. • Sump pump discharges to the public sewer is illegal by federal, state, and local law.
<p>Collaboration opportunities:</p>	<p>If you're interested in having an efficient and effective Sewer District, with more affordable rate structure, that will provide the sustainable system capacity to meet the growth needs of the Brunswick community – then we need your help:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To identify which homes and businesses have sump pumps connected to the public sewer. • So we can map where in our system these are located. • And plan, with the help of the Town and Property Owners, • where the storm water system needs to be expanded or installed to accept sump pump discharges.
