IN CONSIDERATION OF THIS APPLICATION, THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES:

1. To know, accept, and abide by the provisions of the Brunswick Sewer District Charter, all acts additional and amendatory thereto, and all ordinances, policies, rules and regulations adopted thereunder, as may now be in effect or may later be adopted, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.
2. To enter the public sewer system at a location determined by the District.
3. To be responsible for bringing the building sewer to its connection with the public sewer system and for maintaining the building sewer, at no expense to the District.
4. To be responsible for securing and complying with all conditions of required permits.
5. To furnish any additional information relative to the proposed work that shall be requested by the General Manager/Asst. General Manager of the Sewer District.
6. No person or firm shall build, fill, pave over and/or excavate any existing manhole, sewer main or sewer service line without prior approval of the Brunswick Sewer District.
7. To notify the General Manager/Asst. General Manager or duly appointed representative when the work is ready for inspection (**24 hours minimum notice required**). All work is to be under the direct supervision of the District's authorized representative.
8. To be responsible for complying with all conditions of Maine Dig-Safe statutes and regulations.
9. To install a potable water meter if water is provided by a source other than a public water system.
